We are sorry, but due to staff and budget constraints we cannot fill research requests without charging a fee.

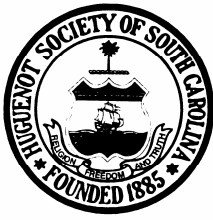
A copy of our Research Request form is enclosed or attached for your convenience.
